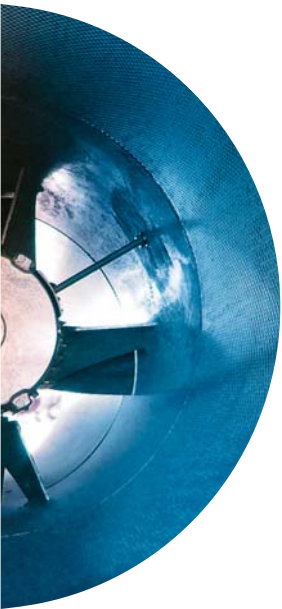

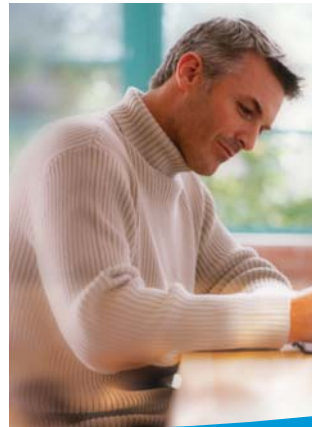


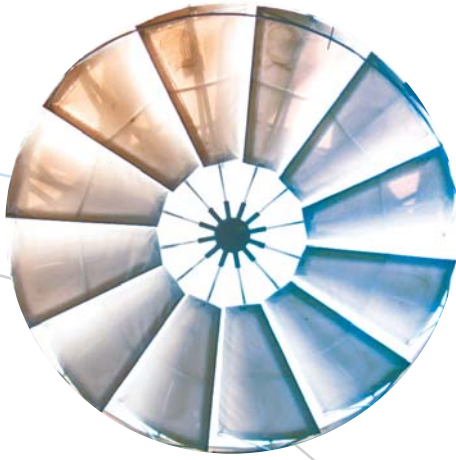

The South African Qualification Certification Committee for Gas (SAQCC Gas) has been accredited by the Department of Labour to register “Authorized Persons”. SARACCA, as a member of that committee is tasked with registering refrigeration and air conditioning practitioners.

In terms of regulation 6 (2) of the Electrical Installation Regulations, 2009, any person carrying out electrical installations operating as an electrical contractor is required to register annually with the Chief Inspector of the Department of Labour, or a person appointed by the Chief Inspector.

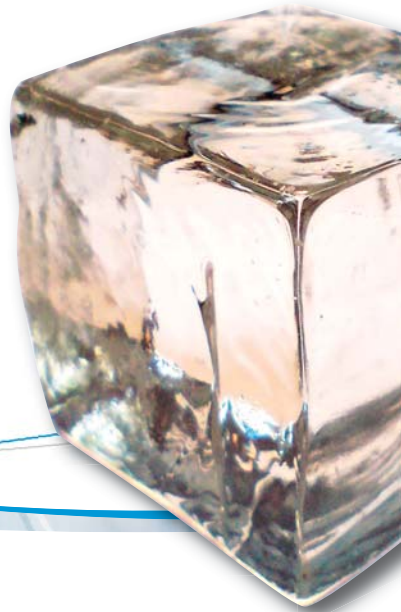
The Chief Inspector has appointed the Electrical Contracting Board of South Africa (ECB) for this purpose.

Pressure Equipment Regulations

Our industry is governed by strict regulations to which we adhere in every aspect of our business dealings with you our valued client. The Minister of Labour published on 15 July 2009, an amendment to the **Occupational Health and Safety Act 1993 in respect of the 'Pressure Equipment Regulations' No. 32395.**

These regulations set out the requirements regarding the design, manufacture, operation, repair, modification, inspection and testing of pressure equipment with a design pressure equal to or greater than 50kPa, in terms of the relevant health and safety standard incorporated into the Regulations under section 44 of the Act. The Pressure Equipment Regulations (PER) incorporate the South African Bureau of Standards (SABS) Standards and Codes of Practice relating to all Gases.

AS a result the air conditioning and refrigeration industry is subject to the act.

It is of note that the regulation puts the onus on the end user to insure he/she employs accredited personnel, & that a certificate of compliance is issued for the work done.

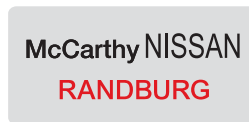

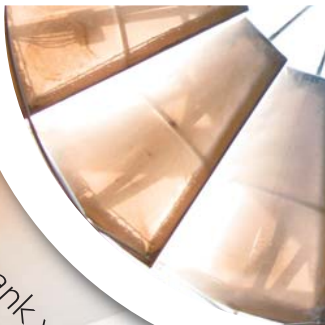
Insuring Your Interests
